  - State of the union message
  - Veto
  - Pardon

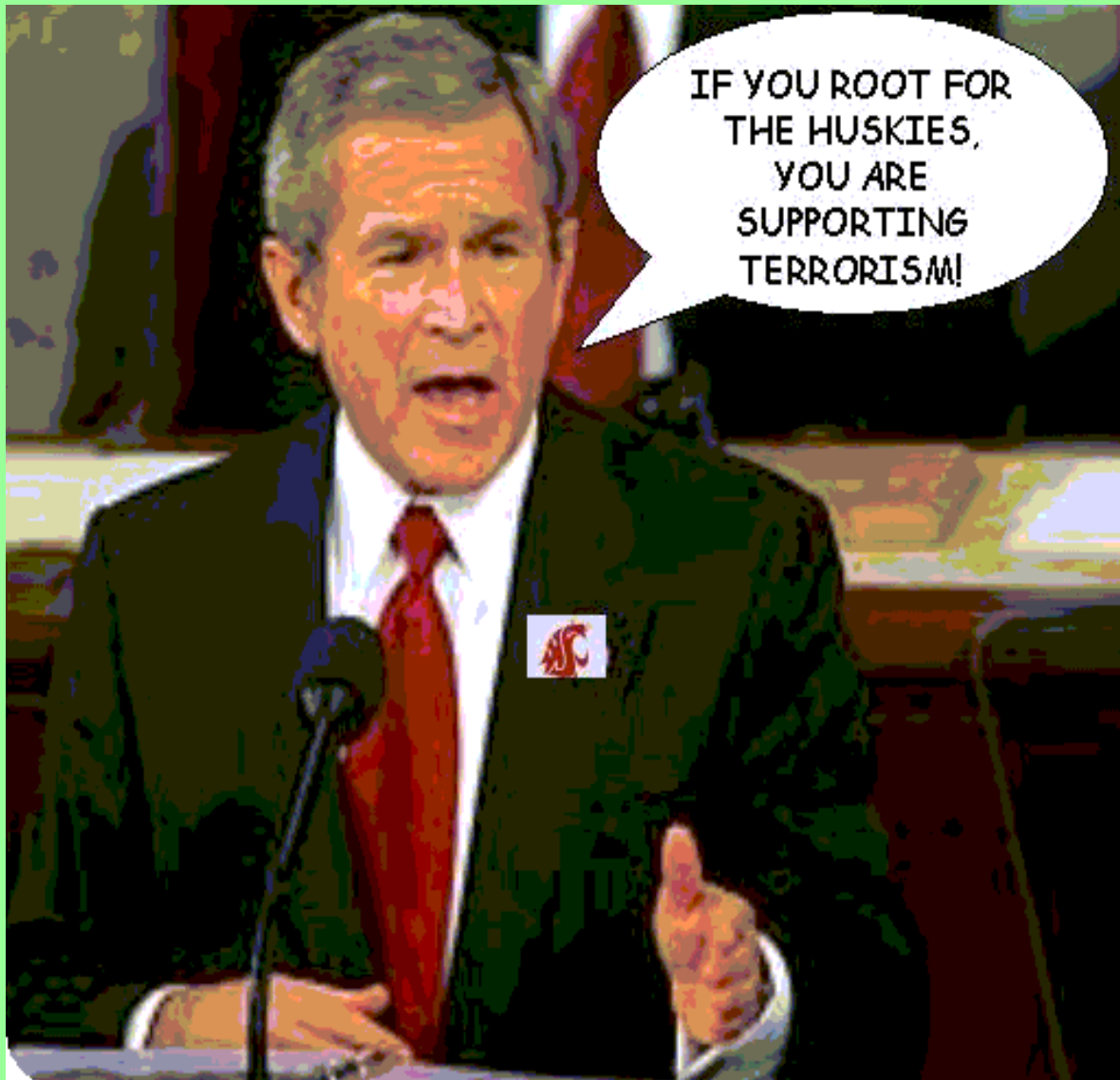
